If there are too many of any one kind of medium, priority of site locations will be given based on date of application. If not accepted, your check will be returned to you. Otherwise your cashed check is your confirmation.

1. Event will be held regardless of weather. Please plan to secure your site with that in mind. You will be setting up in a tar parking lot. The Westminster Cracker Festival is not responsible for damage to your wares or equipment. Set up and equipment must fit within the boundaries of your site space. Sorry, NO REFUNDS.
